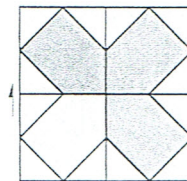
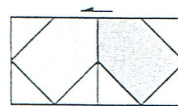
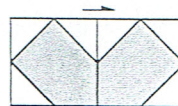


1 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each light square. Lay a marked square on opposite corners of a 3 1/2" square, right sides together. Sew on the marked lines. Trim 1/4" from the stitching lines. Press the seam allowances toward the corners. Repeat on one additional corner.



2 Lay out four units from step 1 in two horizontal rows of two units each. Sew the units in each row together. Press the seam allowances in opposite directions. Join the rows. Press the seam allowances in one direction.

The block should measure 6 1/2" square.

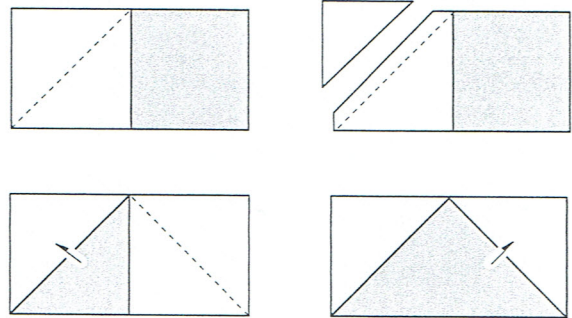

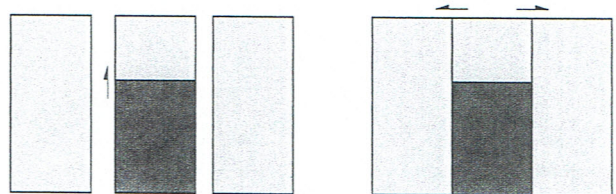

Make the House Blocks

1 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each white print $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Lay a marked square on one end of a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, right sides together as shown. Sew on the marked line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the stitching line. Press the seam allowances toward the corner. Lay another marked square on the opposite end of the rectangle as shown; stitch, trim, and press as before to make a flying-geese unit for the roof.



2 Sew a 2 " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " house rectangle to the top of a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " door rectangle. Press the seam allowances toward the house rectangle. Sew matching $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 " house rectangles to the sides of the unit. Press the seam allowances toward the house rectangles.



3 Sew a roof unit to the top of each house unit. Press the seam allowances open. Join an assorted green $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the bottom of each unit. Press the seam allowances open. Add a white $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top of each unit. Press the seam allowances open. The blocks should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 ".
